



# ELLIS SCHOOL UNIFORMS

## School Year 2025/2026

The Ellis School dress code was established by our families and School Site Council to promote school safety and wellness of all students. Students are encouraged to wear uniforms to promote school spirit and unity.

**Tops:** Blue or white shirt, blouse or sweater. Hoods are not permitted to be worn inside the school building. Uniform tops are not required to have the Ellis logo.



**Bottoms:** Blue or khaki-colored pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers. Uniform bottoms are not required to have the Ellis logo.



**Shoes:** Only closed-toe shoes are permitted. Sneakers must be worn on gym days. For safety, open-toe shoes, flip-flops, house slippers, Crocs, and bubble slippers are not allowed.

**Appropriate Attire:** Students are expected to wear appropriate clothing that is not disruptive, offensive, or distracting to the learning environment. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather.

**Unacceptable Attire:** To maintain a safe and focused learning environment, the following attire is not permitted at school:

- Clothing with offensive language or images.
- Hats, hoods, masks, or other head coverings (unless worn for religious or medical reasons).
- Pajamas (except on designated days).
- Crop tops, and shorts or skirts with a hemline shorter than the wearer's fingertips when their arms are at their sides.
